It is hard to believe that in a few weeks we will already be celebrating the birthday of our wonderful Lord Jesus.

We in Vision for Africa will give special joy to Jesus this year by bringing a real blessing to hundreds of poor families in all our centers.

I will tell you about this at the end of the letter and give you the opportunity to participate in this blessing.

But before that, we want to send a heartfelt thanks to you and especially to the Lord Jesus. So many blessings have flowed and change has happened in these last months.

One of our greatest miracles happened to my cook, Mama Aisha, who suffered from AIDS for years and even wanted to give me her children so that she could die in peace and without worries - she was in such bad shape. I then called her and asked her what her passion was and she told me "COOKING". Since I was looking for a cook anyway, I immediately hired her and suggested that she raise her children together.

Four months ago, holy anger seized me over Satan's plans to torment people with diseases and I prayed from my heart and full faith in the finished work of Jesus, laid hands on Mama Aisha and commanded the Aids to leave her, since Jesus has already died for this disease and paid the price through His stripes.

Then when I came back from Europe, after my last preaching trip, Mama Aisha looked so healthy and vibrant.

Pastor Daniel Exler, who visited us for two weeks, then laid hands on her again and prayed for the release of healing.

In the meantime, Mama Aisha has already been tested twice and is now COMPLETELY NEGATIVE!





So no more AIDS - medically an incurable disease, but not for Jesus Christ, the beginner and perfecter of our faith.

We give ALL HONOR AND ALL THANKS to the Lord Jesus Christ!

Also among the staff we recognize a new unity of love and great harmony among each other and helpfulness to serve.

We also had the strong impression from the Lord that many of our 1000+ co-workers, should still get their lives in order, and get their "sloppy" (non) marriages in order before God and man.

We are so thankful that we have had so many marriages and have many more coming.

You will see from the photos that the joy was truly "heavenly" and all testify that they now recognize and experience the grace and favor of God in a special way on their lives.

We have also seen miracle after miracle in the individual Headquarters.

From Karamoja we can report that the construction of the 7 year old elementary school for 700 children is progressing in great steps, although it is very difficult to deliver the building materials to this remote north in time. The construction should be finished by the end of April.

On Prayer Mountain we are building a large and very modern clinic (with operating rooms, maternity ward with incubators, dentist, ear doctor and of course some surgeons and general practitioners with enough nurses and the rest of the administrative staff). Construction is also progressing very quickly and is also expected to be in full operation by mid-2021.

The Ministry of Health has even given us a donation for this hospital of 100,000 Euros. This is a first and we are so grateful because every euro helps.

In Nakifuma, the construction of the boarding school for 1,600 young middle school girls is also progressing with wonderful unfolding.











The assembly hall for 4,000 people (for students and staff) is also finished except for some technical details and has become beautiful.

Apart from that, we have already repaired and renovated almost everything within the overall structure that was urgently needed for a long time. It all looks like new now and we are very happy.

Also our garden department has "de-cluttered" the plants and cut off the lower lying branches of the trees and bushes, so we have again much more sunshine and overview in and over the whole plant.

We were also able to build a very nice police station in Nakifuma with two empty containers and add another building.

Last week we had a very impressive inauguration and handover of this very successful police station, which is located on the grounds of the middle school in Nakifuma on the road, thus guaranteeing peace and order to the entire area. All our neighbors are very grateful for this extension of security.

It is also such a pleasure for us to have been able to pay all the Vision for Africa staff through this critical time with their monthly salaries. All of them are extremely grateful and have confirmed to us again and again that through this they realize that truly Jesus Christ is the provider and the Lord of Vision for Africa.

So many other factories have laid off their employees and this has left many families in need.

We were even able to provide many of them with sweet potatoes, corn, beans and eggs.

Finally, I would like to give you the opportunity to participate in our Christmas campaign, in the spirit of Jesus, who especially loves the disadvantaged (poor and weak) people.

If you realize that the Lord has carried you and your loved ones through these past months and weeks in His grace, provision and protection, and spared you from attacks of the enemy, then we ask you to pray if







it would not be a great joy to the Lord if you would participate in our Christmas campaign JOY (Jesus, Others, Yourself!).

All of our staff are willing to donate of anything they can give of. Clothes, shoes, children's things, dishes, bedding, wash bowls, etc.) and almost all of them have asked us to use 10% of your November salary to buy food, etc.

We have neveree had such giving employees.

Now I have talked with my co-workers how we could help our dear brothers, sisters, friends and supporters in Europe to give specific gifts in different price ranges to the Lord Jesus as a Christmas gift.

Now here is the list that might give you an idea of what you would like to contribute to this Christmas JOY campaign as a Christmas gift to Jesus. They are only suggestions!

Here you can participate in blessing 500 very poor families as the Holy Spirit puts it on your heart.

Per family, this package of love costs us 15 euros (with packaging and transport:

5 kg. rice, 5 kg. Polenta, 3 kg. of beans, oil, salt, sugar, toothbrushes and toothpastes, Vaseline and matches!

Good woolen blankets (now every year it is cooler in our country and it rains more than ever!) cost 10 to 15 euros per piece


Mattresses 40 to 50 Euro depending on size

towels 8 to 10 Euro

Plastic bowls for bathing and washing in different sizes 3 to 6 Euro

Rubber boots depending on size 8 to 10 Euro
