
So dear saints, we must put our hand in His HANDS so that He will hold us strong and empower us as we walk with Him.

The progress with the former prostitutes who are now getting an education and whose children we include in our school program so that they may lead a life pleasing to God.










If the Lord puts on your heart to be an active participant in this action of God's love for the poor, ask the Lord to show you how much you should contribute.


And do not forget that what we give to the poor, we lend to God. And our Heavenly Father pays it all back as many blessings.

LOVE: The commandment of love is the greatest and most noble commandment that Jesus has shown us. LOVE made Jesus give His life for us!

I am talking about believers who can quote a large number of scriptures and speak the name of JESUS 30 or 40 times a day and yet are hard and uncaring about the needs of their friends and family.

They are so busy "serving GOD" that they have no time to love people. Strife is their hallmark.

You may have been saved for 40 years; you may read the Bible all day, listen to devotional songs, or speak in tongues; but if you have strife in your heart and are not living according to the LOVE COMMANDMENT OF JESUS.

then spiritual things are obviously foolishness to you!

If you are in this condition, then the NAME OF JESUS will produce nothing for you.

Your faith will produce nothing, because the WORD OF GOD says that FAITH is made effective by LOVE.

In fact, not a single spiritual gift will take effect if you do not have love! This is what 1 Corinthians 13 conveys to us.

Therefore, JESUS answers the question of the scholars with:

"You shall love the LORD your GOD with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind".

This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is equal to it: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself".

In these two commandments is contained ALL that law & prophets devise.


Matthew 22: 37-40

Do you want to see the unbelievable POWER OF GOD released in your life? Then start putting the love commandment into practice! Start loving GOD & others around you today.


