"I had a dream, Joseph. I don't quite understand it, but I think it was about the birthday party for our son.



Everything was so beautiful, Joseph, and everyone was so joyful, but I would have preferred to cry. How sad for our Son Jesus Christ that he was not invited to his own birthday party! I'm glad it was only a dream, Joseph. How terrible if that dream was reality!"

One of our co-workers found this wonderful truck that can make evangelism in the villages and towns much easier for us in every way (time and money). We are still in the process of discipling the pastors of the respective evangelism sites. We have also been promised thousands of Bibles in different languages by a dear brother from Europe. In Uganda alone there are 63 different languages. As you can see, we are dealing with a great preliminary work.


